

2014 was a milestone year at Apollos. Of the many advances and improvements we made to our university over the past year, one important achievement was the approval by the Distance Education Accreditation Commission (Formally DETC) (http://www.deac.org/) for Apollos to offer 8 week terms in the graduate programs. Our undergraduate students have been studying in the 8 Week Terms since the inception of the programs, but our graduate offerings were offered in 12 Week Terms since the opening of the university in 2005. Today, graduate students can register for 8 or 12 classes. This provides significant flexibility for Apollos' students.


